

GOVERNMENT OF PONDICHERRY

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F. 5/4/65-GP., dated the 11th January, 1965, of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, and in supersession of the erstwhile Revenue and Development Department's Notification No.9267/68 Coop., dated 1st November, 1969 as published in supplement to the Gazette No. 4 of the 27th January 1970, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'B' post of Dairy Development Officer in the Co-operative Department, Government of Pondicherry, namely : -

1. Short title and commencement. -(1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Co-operative Department, Group 'B' post of Dairy Development Officer Recruitment Rules, 1984.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. Number of posts, their classification and scale of pay.-The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications. -The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications. - No person, -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.-Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.-Nothing in these rules shall affect

- (1) the reservations, relaxations in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard; and
- (2) the appointment and promotion already made in accordance with the rules hereby superseded.

(Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same organization/department shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years). |

12. If a D.P.C./R.C. exists, what is its composition? Not applicable.
13. Circumstances in which the U.P.S.C. is to be consulted in making recruitment Selection on each occasion shall be made in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission. Consultation with the Union Public Service Commission also necessary while amending/relaxing any of the provisions of these rules.
