➤ **The Co-operative department**

- Registers need based societies,
 - Instills democratic character in managing societies,
 - Assists societies for sustainable development,
 - Conducts timely audit,
 - Inspects and holds inquiries whenever warranted,
 - Settles disputes in cost effective way and provides speedy justice.
- Co-operative societies are value based business organisations providing goods and services to the members and public with devotion and business ethics.
- Co-operative societies ensures members participation on the basis of ‘one member one vote’ in self-governing management, equitable distribution of profit, dignity of labour and co-operation among co-operatives.
- Co-operative department imparts training to the members of the societies on their rights and duties, to the members of the managing committee on their role in effective management and to the employees of the department and societies to hone their skills and update their knowledge.
- The co-operative societies which are substantially funded by the Government are brought under the purview of the Right to Information Act, 2005 to make them more transparent and accountable in their functioning.
- The department hosts the orders of the First Appellate Authority under the Right to Information Act and Revision Petitions under the Puducherry Co-operative Societies Act in the website for dissemination of effective justice.
