

GOVERNMENT OF PONDICHERRY

DEPARTMENT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (CO-OPERATION)

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. 24/78/68-D.H. (S), dated 24th September, 1968 and No. F. 5/4/65 -GP., dated the 11th January, 1965, of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, the Lieutenant - Governor of Pondicherry, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group `A' post of Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies in the Co-operative Department, Pondicherry, namely : -

1. *Short title and commencement.* -(1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Co-operative Department, Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies Recruitment Rules, 1988.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Applications.* -These rules shall apply for recruitment to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Number of posts, their classification and scale of pay.*-The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.* -The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

5. *Disqualifications.* - No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. *Power to relax.*-Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. *Saving.* - Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF JOINT REGISTRAR OF CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES

| 3. Classification | General Central Services Group `A'- Gazetted (Non-Technical). |
| 4. Scale of pay | Rs. 2,200-75-2,800-EB-100-4,000. |
| 5. Whether selection post or non-selection post. | Not applicable. |
| 6. Age limit for direct recruits | Not exceeding 35 years (Relaxable for Government servants upto 5 years in accordance with the instructions of orders issued by the Central Government).
Note : The crucial date for determining the limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (other than those in Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep). |
| 7. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under rule 30 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972. | No. |
| 8. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits. | Essential:
(i) Degree in law of a recognized University or equivalent;
OR
Associate Membership of the Institute of Chartered Accountants;
OR
Master's degree in Commerece of a recognized University or equivalent.
(ii) 7 year's experience in a supervisory capacity in the Co-operative field.
Note 1 : Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the U.P.S.C., in case of candidates otherwise not qualified.
Note 2 : The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the U.P.S.C. in case of candidates belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes, if at any stage of selection in U.P.S.C. is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

| 9. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees. | Not applicable |

10. Period of probation, if any Two years.
11. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/ absorption and percentage of the posts to be filled by various methods. By transfer on deputation failing which by direct recruitment
12. In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer is to be made. **Transfer on deputation:**
Officers under the Central/State Government/ Union Territories -
- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on a regular basis; or
 - (ii) with 3/4 years regular service in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 2,000-3,500 /2,000-3,200 or equivalent; or
 - (iii) with 5 years regular service in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 1,640-2,900 or equivalent; and
 - (b) Possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 8 (period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years).
13. If a Departmental Promotion Committee exists, what is its composition ? **Group 'A' Departmental Promotion Committee (for considering confirmation) -**
- (1) Chief Secretary to Government. .. Chairman
 - (2) Secretary(Planning)-cum-Development Commissioner. .. Member
 - (3) Registrar of Co-operative Societies. .. Member
- Note :** The proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation shall be sent to the Commission for approval. If, however, these are not approved by the Commission, a fresh meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or a Member of the Union Public Service Commission shall be held.
14. Circumstances in which the Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment Selection on each occasion shall be made in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission.
